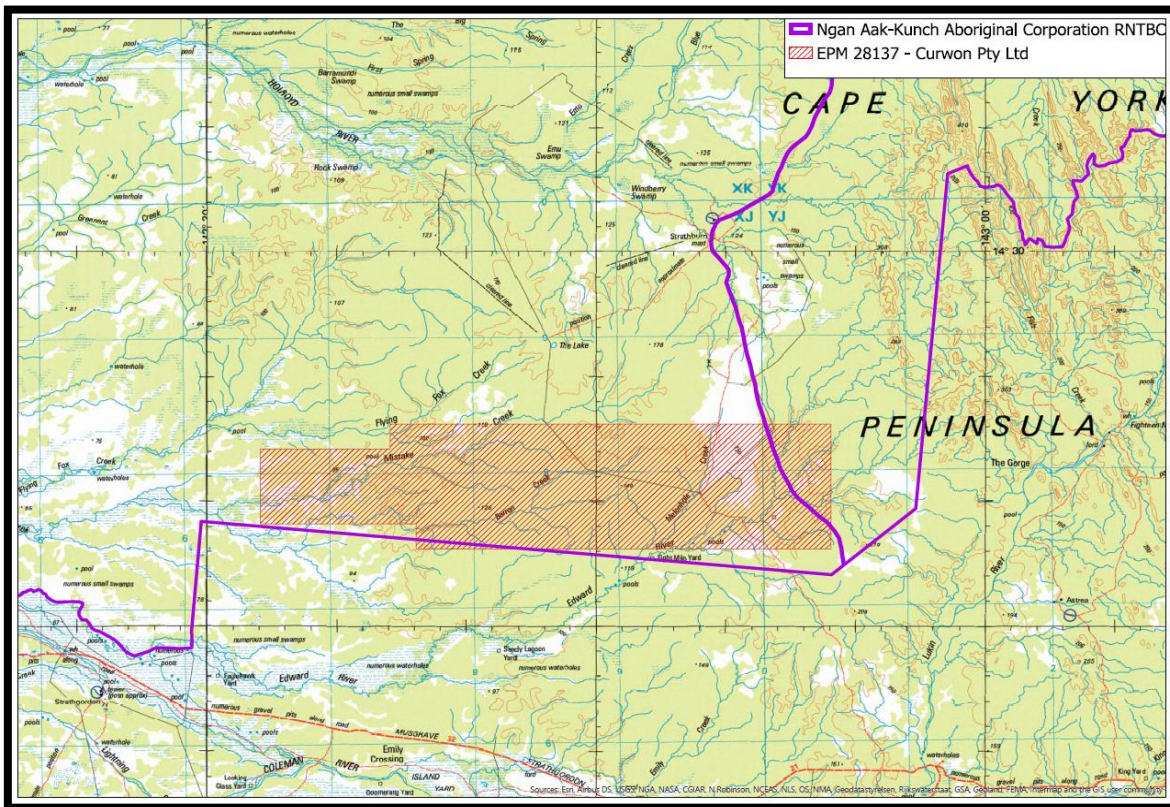
**To be held in Pormpuraaw Friday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2023**
