#### Possum Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014)

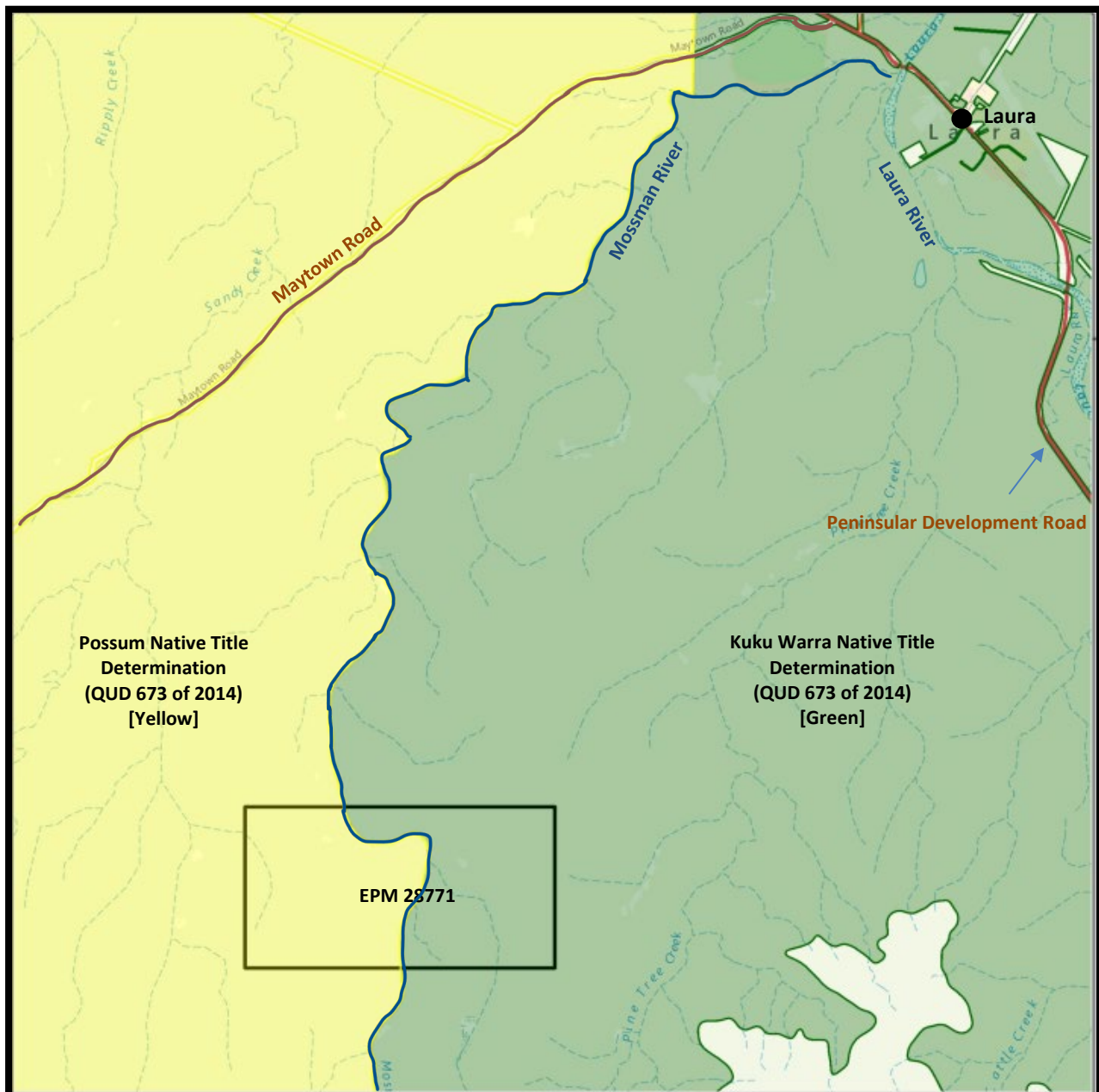
On 17 July 2024, the State of Queensland issued a notification under section 29(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) identifying that proposed Exploration Permit for Minerals (EPM) 28771 is an act attracting the expedited procedure.
