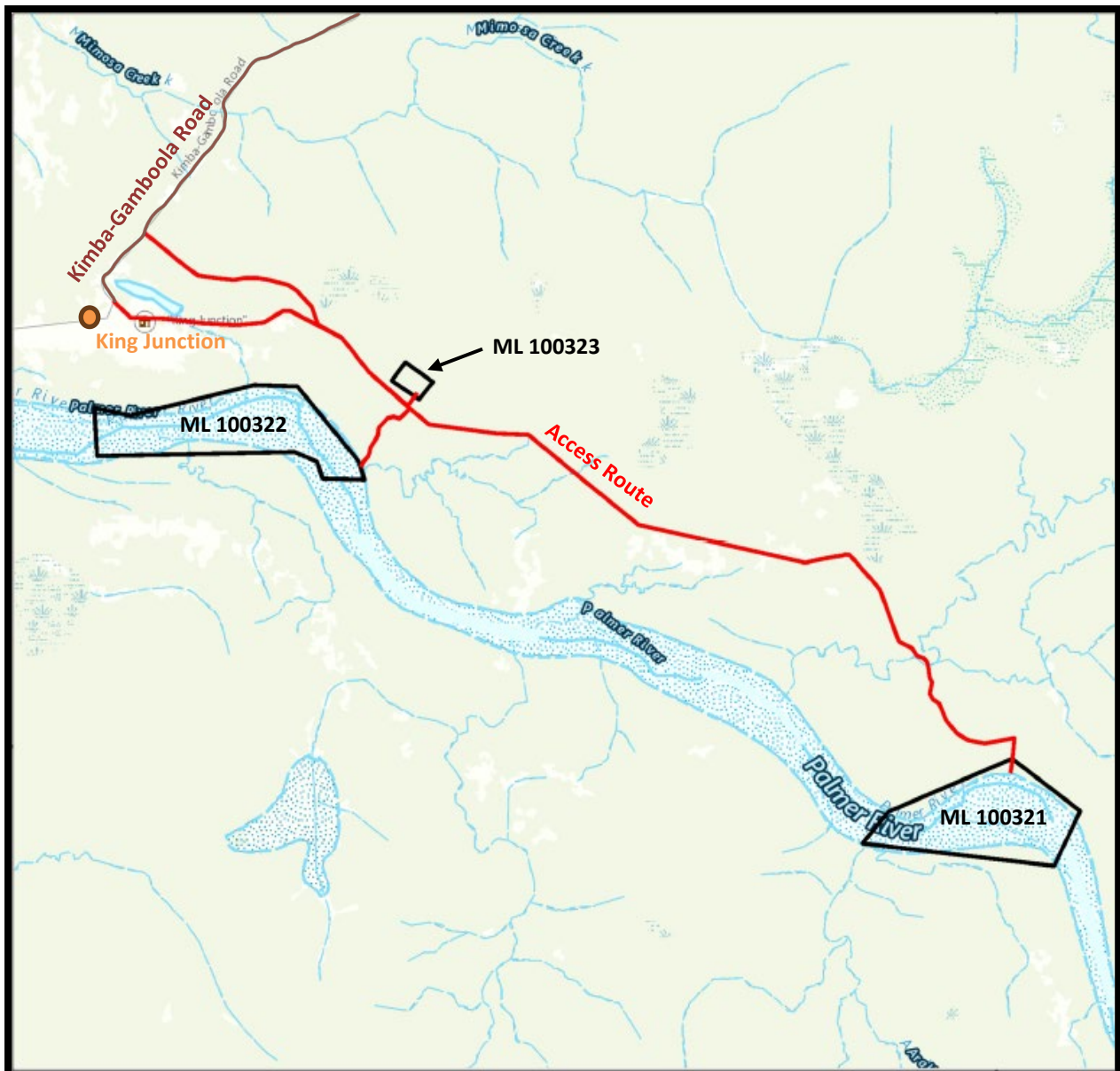
Ross on behalf of the Cape York United #1 Claim Group v State of Queensland (No 25) (Kunjen Olkol determination) [2024] FCA 741 (QUD 673 of 2014)

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a meeting with the Kunjen Olkol native title group regarding the area subject to the proposed grant of Mining Leases (MLs) 100321, 100322 and 100323 held by Aurum Vale Pty Ltd (as shown on the map below). The Mining Leases were originally notified on 12 October 2022, and then subsequently re-notified on 24 April 2024, under s. 29 of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (NTA) and are subject to the right to negotiate under s. 31 of the NTA.
