Cape York United #1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014)

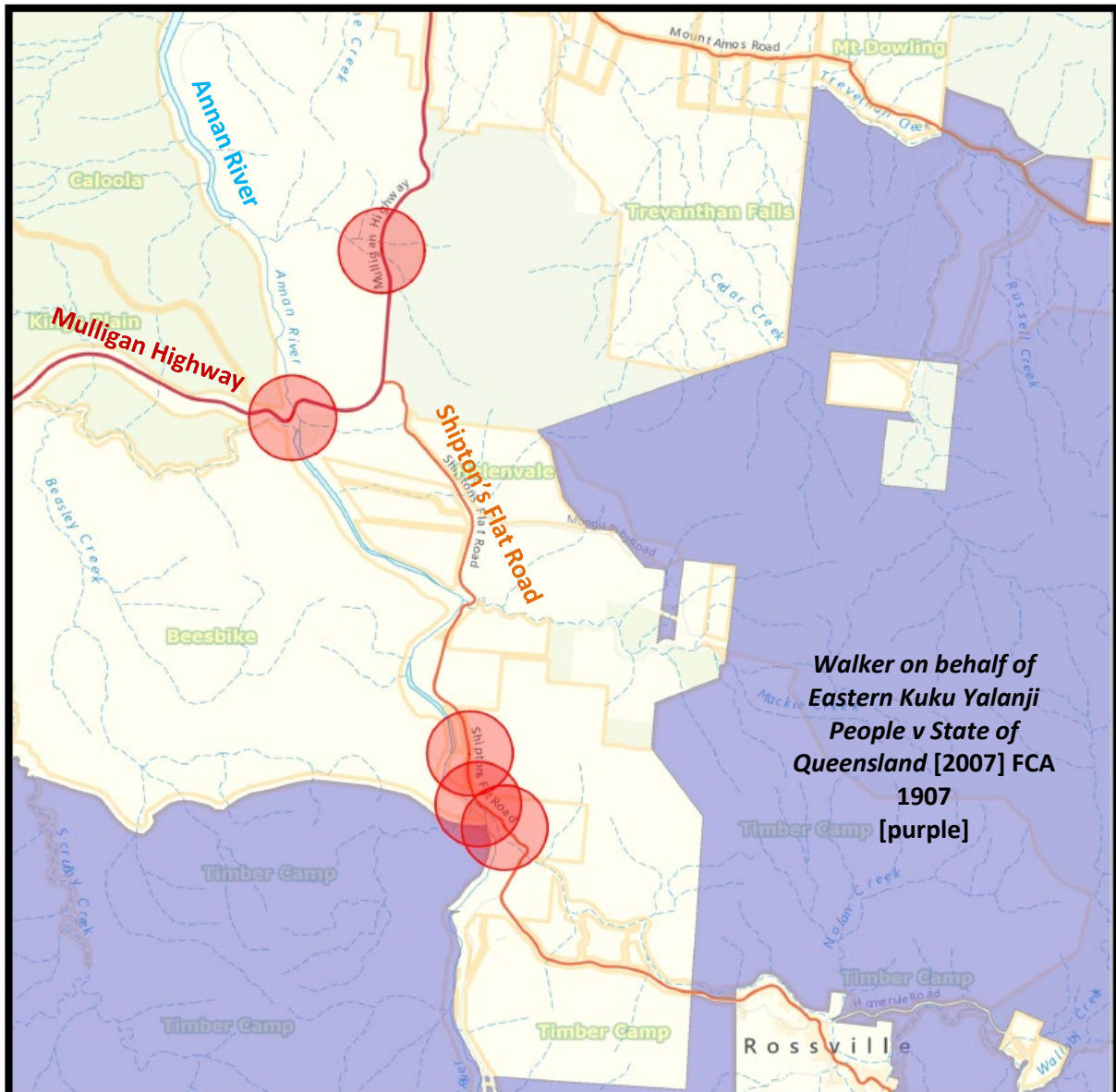
On 22 January 2025, the Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR) issued a notification to the Applicant of the Cape York United Number 1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014) (CYU#1 Claim) identifying its proposal to undertake repair and stabilising works at slip sites along the Mulligan Highway and Shipton's Flat Road (as shown on the map below in red).

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold or may hold Native Title rights and interests within the CYU#1 Claim area subject to the repair and stabilising works proposed by DTMR.
