Purpose of Meeting

The purpose of this meeting is to:

- Confirm the proposed boundaries of the Guugu Yimidhirr Native Title Group;
- Confirm the proposed list of apical ancestors which make up the group description for the Guugu Yimidhirr Native Title Group;
- Provide an update on the CYU#1 Claim and to discuss next steps required to progress towards a determination of native title.

This is an important decision-making meeting and we encourage all members of the Guugu Yimidhirr Native Title Group to attend. The legal representative of the CYU#1 Applicant will take instructions on the group and boundary descriptions for the Guugu Yimidhirr by way of resolution. In accordance with the applicable Federal Court timetable, the group and boundary descriptions must be decided by Guugu Yimidhirr and provided to the State for final agreement.
