Cape York United #1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014)

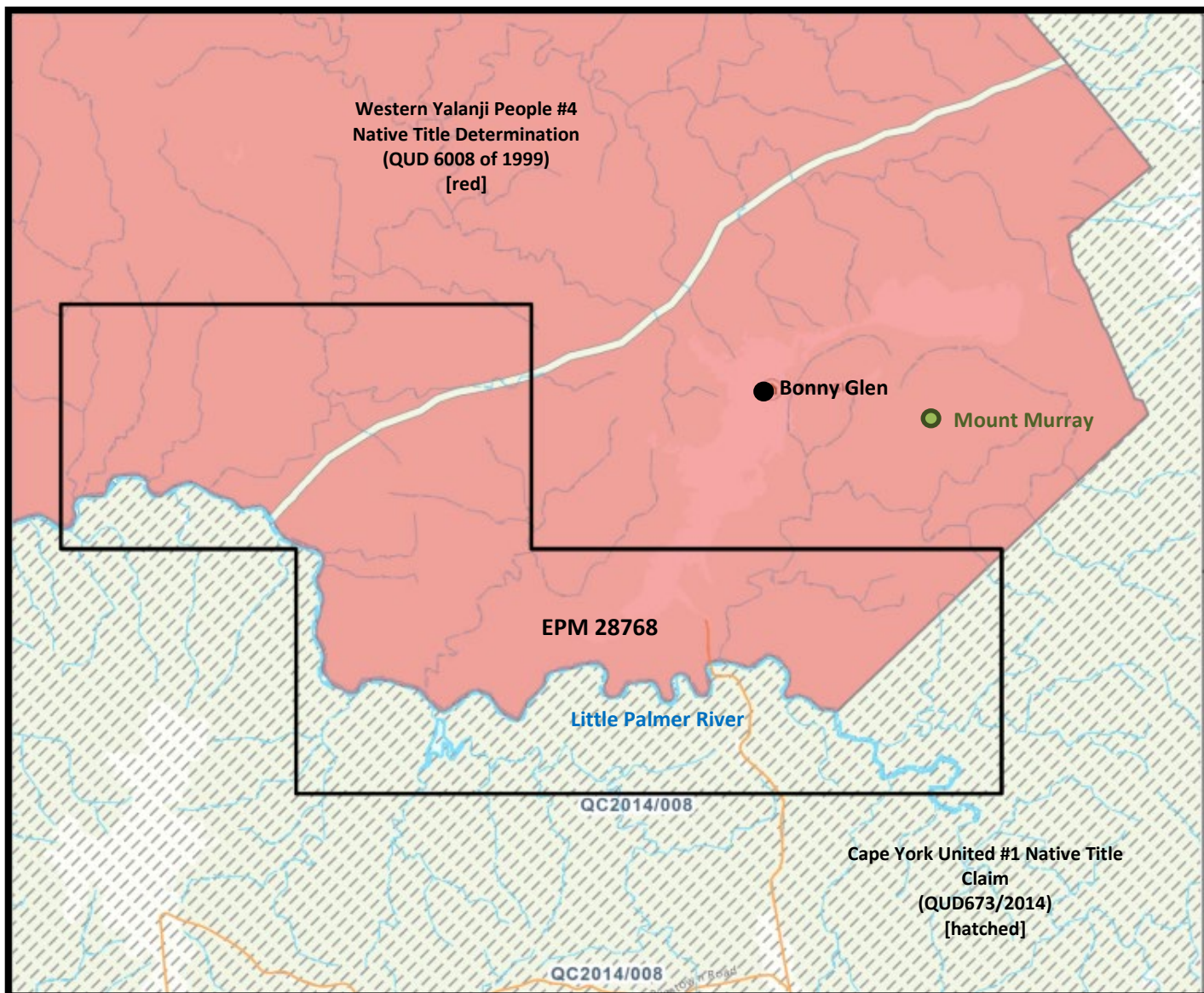
This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold or may hold Native Title rights and interests within the Cape York United #1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014) (CYU#1 Claim) subject to the proposed grant of EPM 28768 to Warren James Mulcahy (as shown on the map below in the **hatched** area).

The Explorer has commenced full enquiry proceedings with the National Native Title Tribunal (NNTT). At this meeting, CYLC will discuss with the Native Title Party the NNTT's full enquiry process and the options available to progress this matter.
