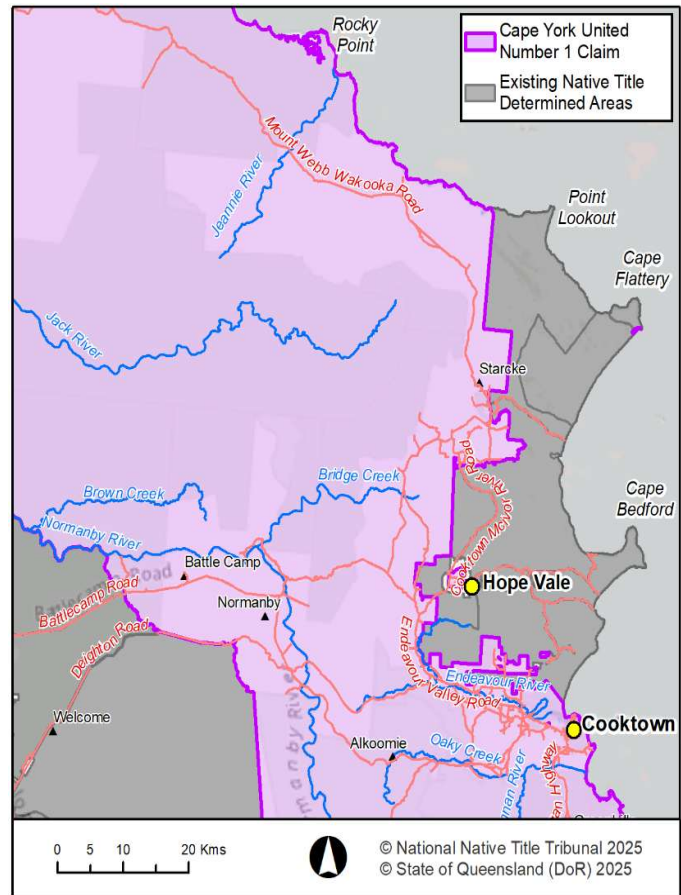
What is the purpose of this meeting?

The purpose of this meeting is:

1. to **CONSIDER**, and if appropriate **CONFIRM** the *proposed Guugu Yimidhirr apical ancestors* (additional to those already accepted) for inclusion in the group description for the Guugu Yimidhirr Native Title Group; and
2. for the legal representatives of the CYU#1 Applicant to provide an **UPDATE** and **DISCUSS** the next steps required to progress towards a determination of native title for the Guugu Yimidhirr Native Title Group in October 2025, which include a PBC workshop and authorisation meetings.

Who may attend this meeting?

All Guugu Yimidhirr People, including persons descended from the *proposed Guugu Yimidhirr apical ancestors*, are eligible and invited to attend this meeting.
