EPM 28637 – Rhumb Resources Pty Ltd

Possum Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014)

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (**CYLC**) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold Native Title rights and interests within the Possum Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014) subject to the proposed grant of Exploration Permit for Minerals (**EPM**) 28637 to Rhumb Resources Pty Ltd (as shown on the map below in **blue**).

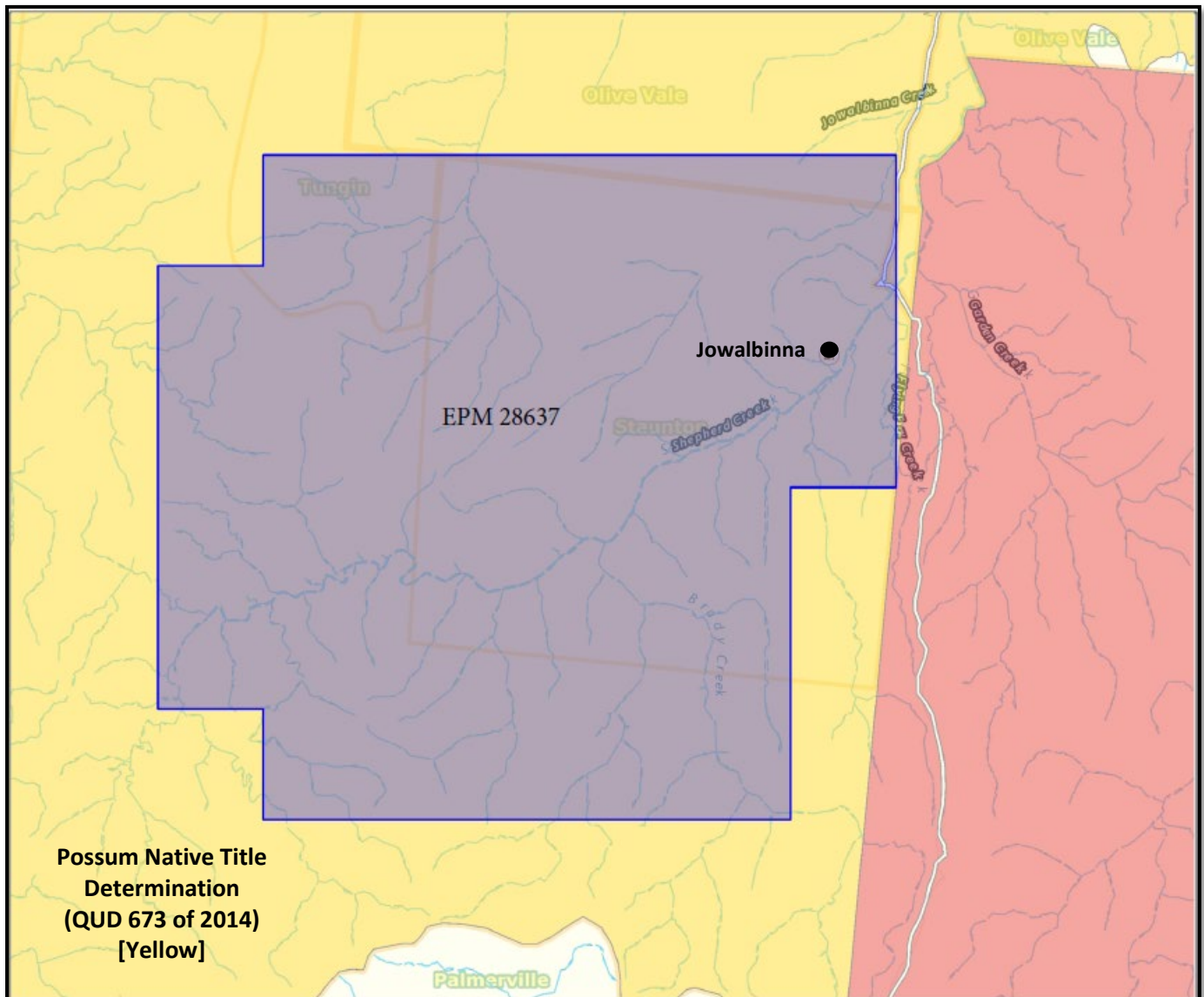
On 8 May 2024, the State of Queensland issued a notification under section 29(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (**NTA**) identifying that the proposed grant of EPM 28637 is an act attracting the expedited procedure.

On 1 July 2025, CYLC received instructions to invite Rhumb Resources Pty Ltd to attend the next meeting in-person to discuss its project. **A representative of Rhumb Resources Pty Ltd has confirmed their attendance in-person at this meeting.**
