The purpose of this meeting is:

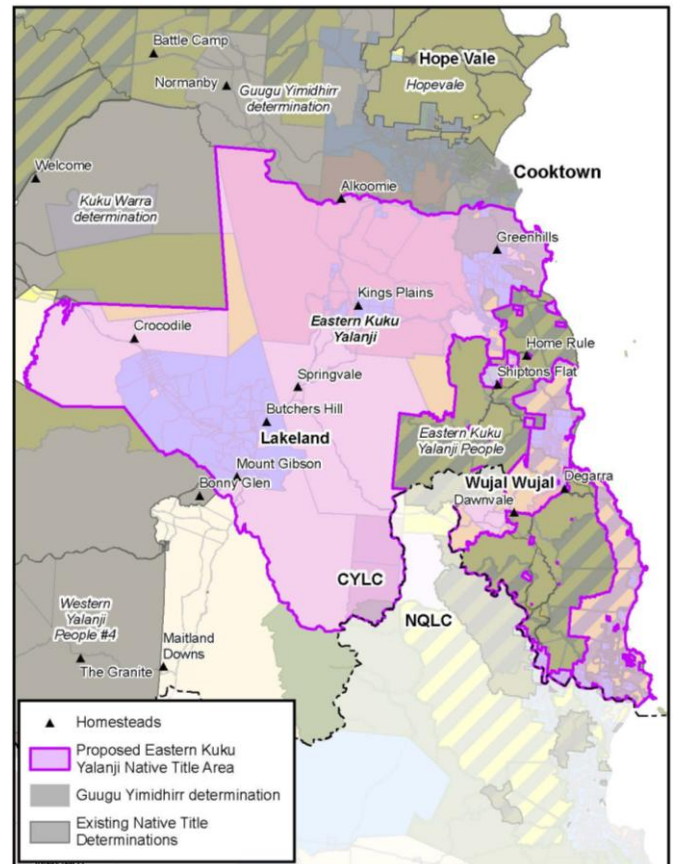
1. to further **CONSIDER**, and if appropriate **CONFIRM** a number of potential additional apical ancestors for inclusion in the draft group description for the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Native Title Group; and
2. for the legal representatives of the CYU#1 Applicant to provide an **UPDATE** and **DISCUSS** the next steps required to progress towards a determination of native title for the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Native Title Group.

Who may attend this meeting?

All members of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Native Title Group are eligible and invited to attend this meeting. If you are unsure as to whether you are a person who may attend this meeting, please contact CYLC's Anthropology Unit.

As this is an important decision-making meeting, all members of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji Native Title Group are strongly encouraged to attend. The CYU#1 Expert Genealogist Kate Waters will present on the apical ancestors and will also have availability to meet with families on request.

This is the last opportunity for the legal representatives of the CYU#1 Applicant to take instructions on the group description, which it will do by way of resolution.



In accordance with the applicable Federal Court timetable, the group and boundary descriptions must be decided by the Eastern Kuku Yalanji group and provided to the State for final agreement.
