NOTICE OF CONSULTATION

Northern Kaanju common law holder meeting

Ross on behalf of the Cape York United #1 Claim Group v State of Queensland (No 6) (Northern Kaanju determination)
[2022] FCA 770

On 11 July 2017, the Peninsula Developmental Road Indigenous Land Use Agreement (**PDR ILUA**) was registered on the National Native Title Tribunal Register of Indigenous Land Use Agreements. This agreement was authorised to be registered by those people who held or may have held native title rights and interests in the PDR ILUA area. To date, 7 kilometres remain unsealed within the Northern Kaanju determination area.

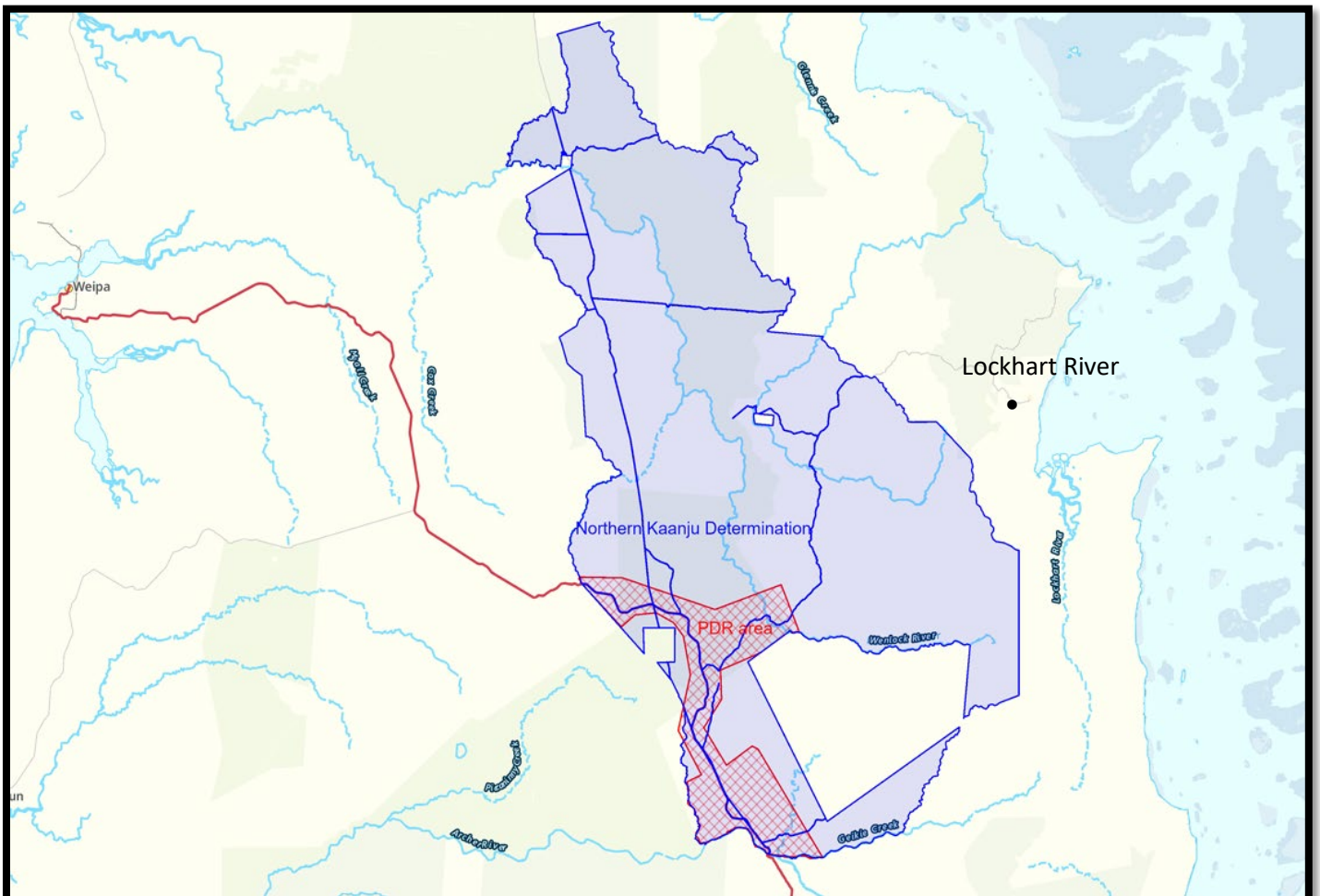
On 8 April 2026, CYLC will facilitate a meeting for those common law holders subject to the native title determination *Ross on behalf of the Cape York United #1 Claim Group v State of Queensland (No 6) (Northern Kaanju determination)* [2022] FCA 770, to discuss the PDR ILUA and the continued performance of this agreement.

Representatives of CYLC and the Department of Transport and Main Roads (**DTMR**) will be available at this meeting to discuss the history, functions, progress and implementation of the PDR ILUA.
