

NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION-MAKING MEETING
ML 100389 – North Queensland Mining Pty Ltd
Cape York United #1 Claim (QUD673/2014)

On 11 September 2024, the State of Queensland issued a notification under section 29(2)(b) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (NTA) to the Registered Native Title Claimant of the Cape York United Number 1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014) (CYU#1 Claim) of the proposed grant of Mining Lease (ML) 100389 to North Queensland Mining Pty Ltd. ML 100389 is subject to the right to negotiate under s.31 of the NTA.

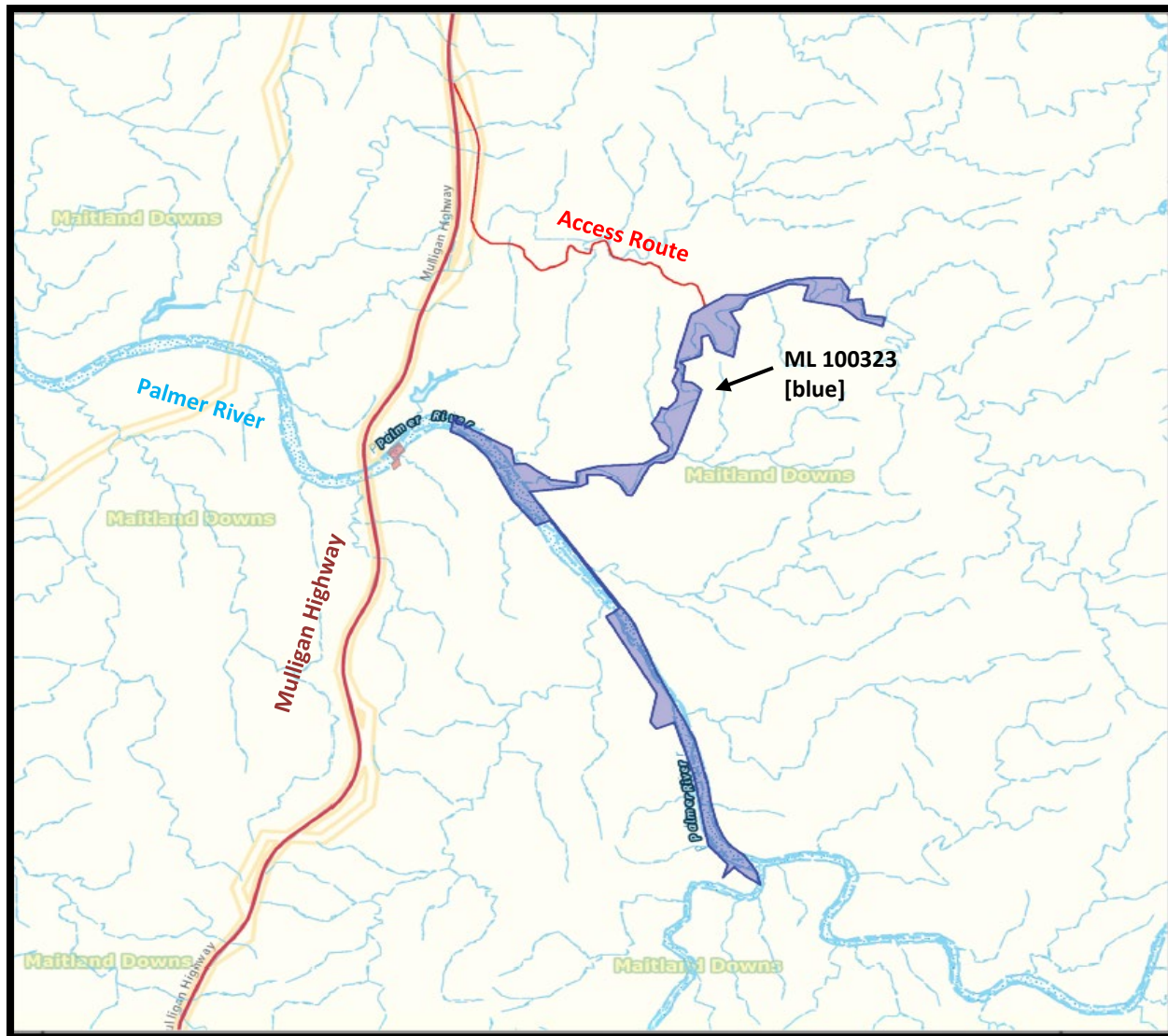
As an outcome of the 31 March 2026 meeting:

- Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a final decision-making meeting with those people who hold or may hold Native Title rights and interests within the area of the CYU#1 Claim subject to the proposed grant of ML 100389 to North Queensland Mining Pty Ltd; and
- A representative of North Queensland Mining Pty Ltd will attend the meeting to discuss the details of its project.
