Cape York United #1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014) and Kunjen Olkol Native Title Determination (QUD 673 of 2014)

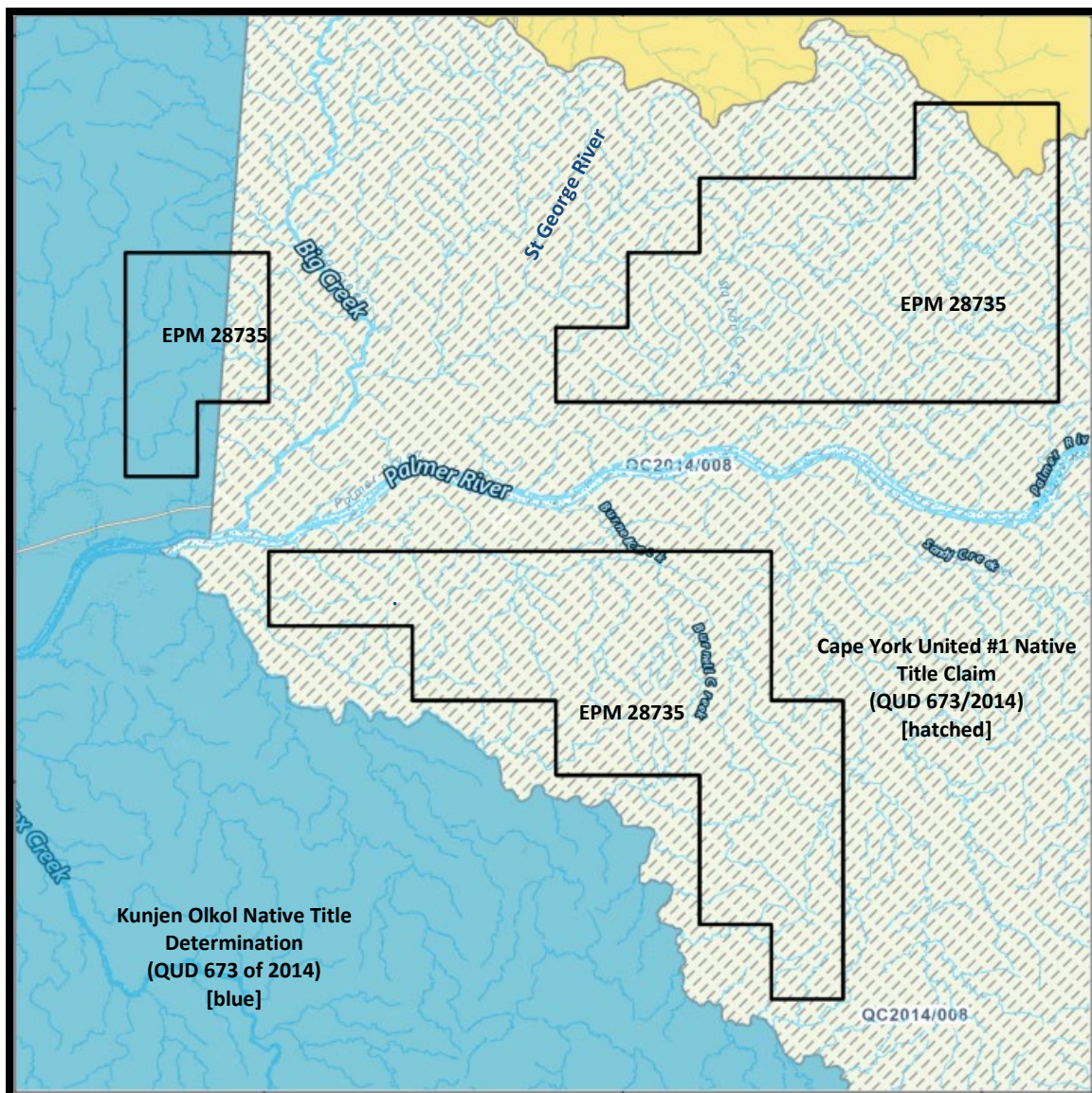
On 17 July 2024, the State of Queensland issued a notification under section 29(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) identifying Exploration Permit for Minerals (EPM) 28735 as an act attracting the expedited procedure.

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold or may hold Native Title rights and interests within the Cape York United #1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014) and the Kunjen Olkol Determination area (QUD 673 of 2014) subject to the proposed grant of EPM 28735 held by Ark Mines Ltd (as shown on the map below in **hatched**) to consider the proposed terms of a cultural heritage agreement.
