Olkola Determination (QUD 673 of 2014)

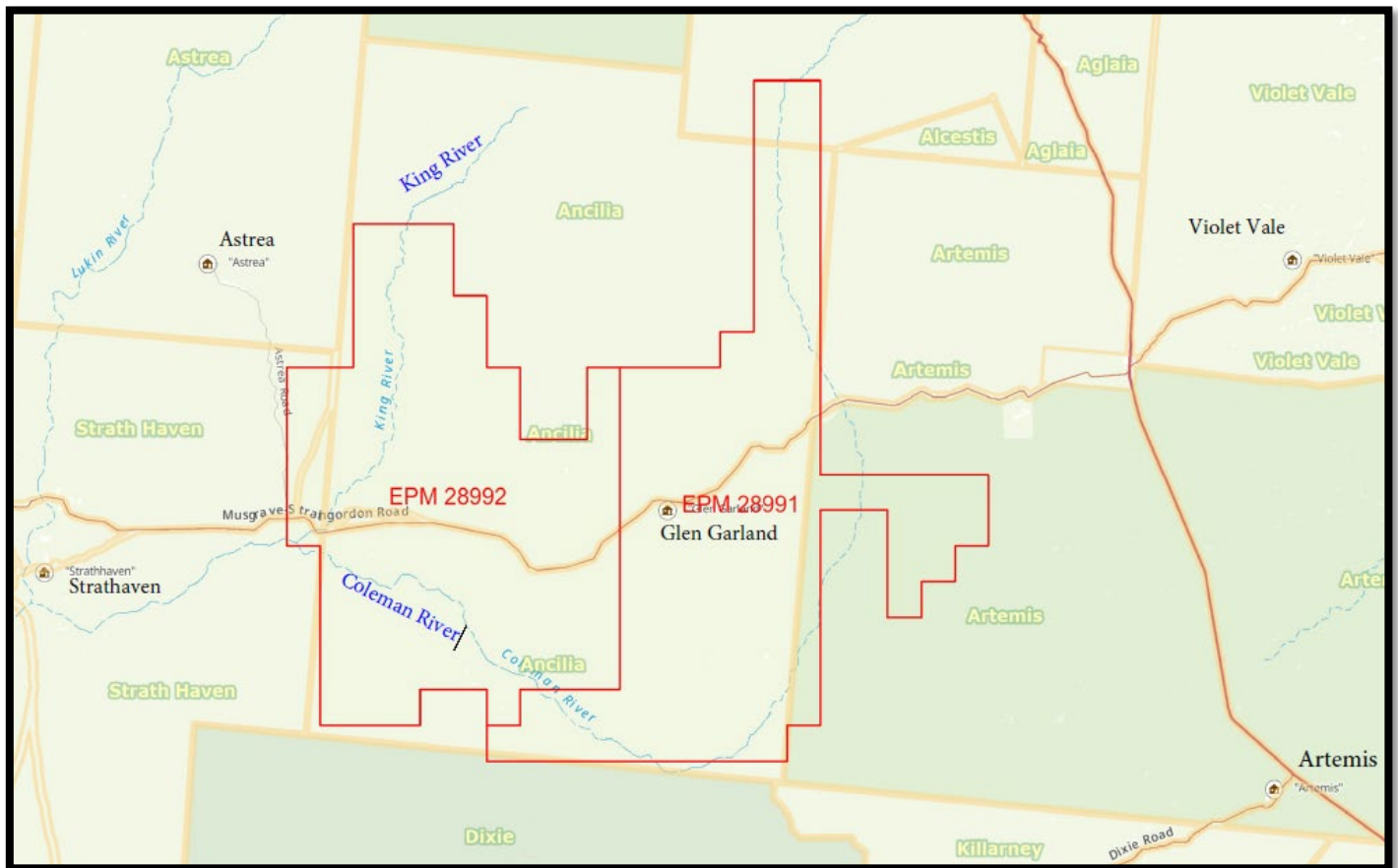
On 12 June 2025, the State of Queensland issued a notification under s.29(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (NTA) identifying Exploration Permits for Minerals (EPMs) 28991 and 28992 as acts attracting the expedited procedure. On 2 February 2026 the expedited statement was removed and EPMs 28991 and 28992 were reclassified as acts that attract the normal negotiation procedure.

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (CYLC) will be facilitating a consultation meeting for those Native Title Holders who hold rights and interests in the area of EPMs 28991 and 28992 (as shown on the map below) within the Ut-Alkar AC RNTBC area. At this meeting, CYLC will discuss the options available to progress this matter.
