Ross on behalf of the Cape York United #1 Claim Group v State of Queensland (No 34) (Guugu Yimidhirr determination) [2025] FCA 1282

On 25 February 2025, the State of Queensland issued a notification under section 29(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) identifying that the proposed Exploration Permit for Minerals (**EPM**) 29225 is an act that attracts the expedited procedure.

This notice is to advise that Cape York Land Council (**CYLC**) will facilitate a meeting with those people who hold Native Title rights and interests within the Guugu Yimidhirr determination area within the proposed grant of EPM 29225 (as shown on the map below in **green**). 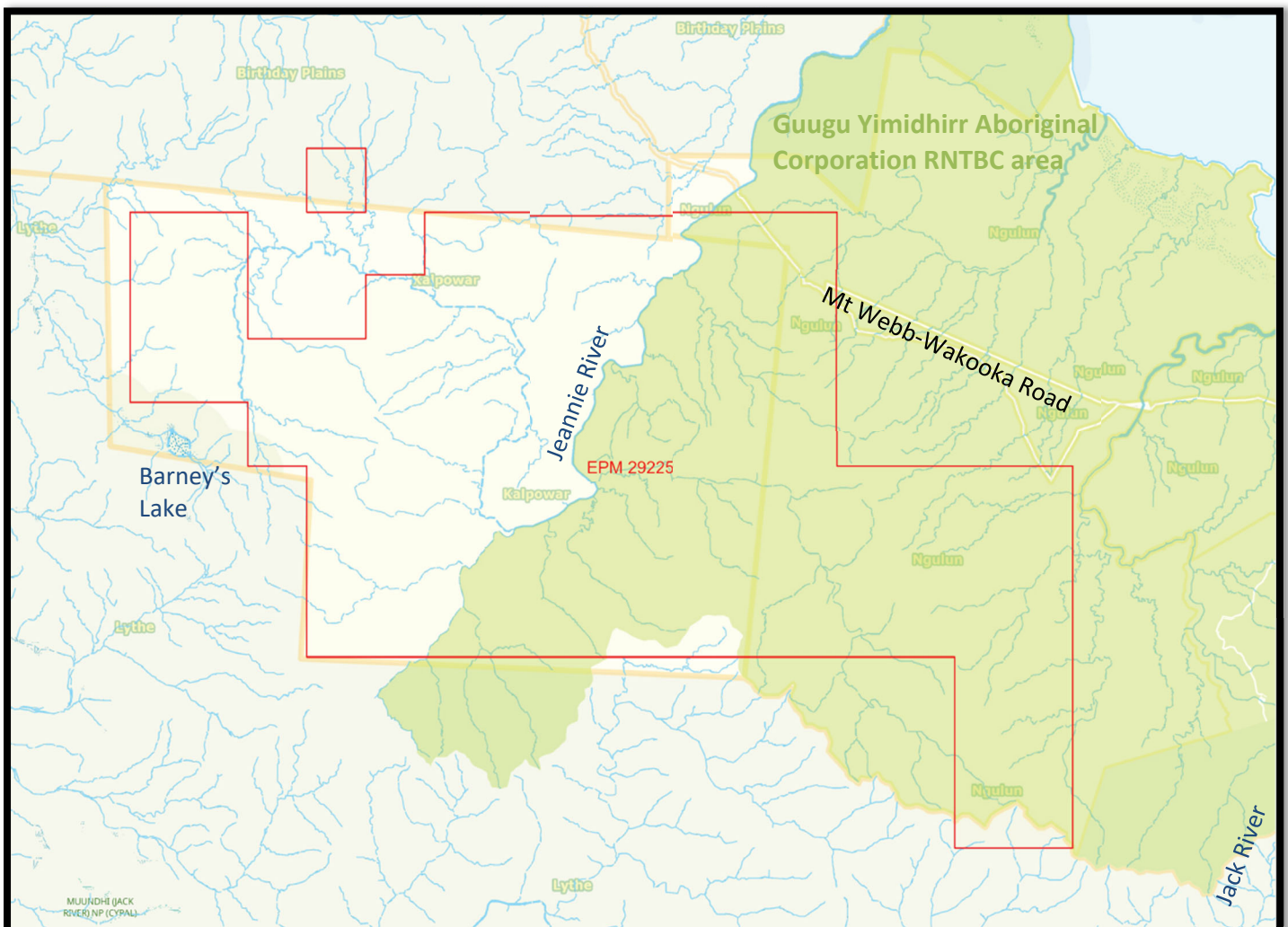
